Executive Director

The Director is accountable to the governing body and must have proven leadership skills and experience at an executive level. Experience in Managed care is desirable.

Clinical Director

The Clinical Director is responsible for all behavioral health related services provided and will oversee the work of Master's level practitioners working on Individual Service Plans for participants. Candidates for this position must have a minimum of 5 years of experience in administering or interpreting functional behavioral assessments and an MS; PhD is preferred.

Medical Director (Part-time)

The Medical Director is responsible for the management of the Physician and Physical health services provided. To qualify, you must be a physician licensed to practice in the Commonwealth of PA; experience in managed care is desired.

Provider Relations Representative

The Provider Relations Representative will assist in the development and maintenance of a provider network designed to serve participants in the program. BS degree and related experience required.
